BePink keeps getting good results on track. From New Zealand to Montichiari, it's podium !

From the road to the track. After the good result in Qatar, Silvia Valsecchi, Simona Frapporti and Giulia Donato were protagonists once more in Montichiari. Yesterday, in fact, the three BePink athletes participated in the Trofeo Erminia Zambelli.

The race was the omnium, which consists of three events: the flying lap, the points race and the scratch.

End result: second place for Giulia Donato and third place for her teammate, Simona Frapporti.

The BePink girls have been summoned once more by the head coach of the Italian national team, Mr Dino Salvoldi: they will be training from the 5th to the 8th of February to continue the preparation for the World Cup in Minsk, one of the first seasonal goals of the team.

Even more good results are coming from overseas: the newzealander athlete Georgia Williams, who is taking part to the New Zealand national track cycling championship, was on the podium twice: she won a silver medal both in the individual pursuit and in the points race.

A really good performance for the young BePink athlete, that will join her teammates over the course of the next few weeks.

A very satisfied team manager, Walter Zini, stated: "The girls are racing well and it showed yesterday during the track race in Montichiari, which is an important test considering the forthcoming World Cup. I'm also very happy about the great results that Georgia is achieving in New Zealand".

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
