**Bev May Women Tour: Georgia Williams on top of New Zealand
The young BePink athlete wins two stages and the general classification.**

The young newzealander athlete Georgia Williams, after her great performance during the recent National track championship, keeps getting great results for the team: two stage wins and the first place in the general ranking of the Bev May Women Tour. The stage race opened with a short time trial : 12 kms of flat route, where Georgia placed third. During the same day, the first stage: 97 kms with lots of ups and downs, a difficult circuit during which Georgia definitely prevailed, arriving alone at the finishing line.

During the second day, there were two more half-stages. The first one ended in a group sprint and with a fourth place for Georgia, which allowed her to still keep the yellow jersey.

The afternoon race was a criterium, a favourite of Georgia, who's national champion in this discipline.

The young athlete won this final race and therefore placed first in the general ranking.

It was a great satisfaction for BePink because these first results on road, add up to the previous ones on track and they bring to five the victories obtained by the team during this start of the season.

"Georgia showed her skills both during time trial races and road races. She dominated the short stage race and after conquering the yellow jersey she managed to keep it on until the very end. She is a very good athlete and I'm sure she'll face new and important challenges during this next season. The experience in our team will surely allow her to grow and learn even more", underlined the team manager Walter Zini.

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
