Malgorzata Wojtyra wins the first race with BePink Simona Frapporti and Giulia Donato are in Mexico for the World Cup

A six days race is always spectacular and exciting. The first victory for BePink in 2013 was conquered by the Polish athlete Malgorzata Wojtyra during the points race.

Malgorzata will also take part in the Six Days race in Berlin, another fundamental step to prepare for the world championship in Minsk.

The track, an old favourite of the team manager Walter Zini, seems to be a favorite of his team as well. The Italian national team's coach, Edoardo Salvoldi, choose two BePink athletes to participate in the third and last stage of the track cycling World Cup.

Simona Frapporti and Giulia Donato will be competing in Aguascalientes, Mexico, from the 17th to the 19th of January. They both are very happy and ready to race:

"I am very satisfied, participating in this race was my first goal for this season and it's a step towards the World Championship" says Simona Frapporti. "The coach trusts me and I'm doing my best to prove him right. I'm sorry I'm not training with my teammates in Spain" adds Simona "but this is an amazing opportunity for me and it's a chance to be prepared for my seasonal debut on the road, during the Ladies Tour of Qatar, at the end of January."

Her teammate Giulia Donato seems to be on the same page: *"I'm happy and confident. We've been working very hard to train during the camp in Benicassim, Spain, and now it's time to show our worth. I have to admit that my first goal for this season is to participate in the track cycling World Championship" stated the young athlete. "I'm very satisfied to compete in the third stage of the World Cup, especially since I had already taken part in the first one, in Colombia, where I won the team pursuit race"*

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
