BePink is ready for another stage race. It's time for the Thüringen Rundfahrt der Frauen.

It's time for another important appointment for BePink: starting tomorrow, Walter Zini's athletes will take part in the Thüringen Rundfahrt der Frauen, a difficult stage race taking place in Germany.

The first stage will start in the afternoon and cover 66 kilometres. It will then be followed by six stages, among them a time trial race.

The main ingredients of this race will be the difficult routes, the high speed required and the hard elevation profile of the road.

The Thüringen Rundfahrt der Frauen will last from July 15th to July 21st.

The athletes that will take place to the race are the national Byelorussian champion Alena Amialiusik, the national Swiss champion Doris Schweizer, Silvia Valsecchi, Georgia Williams, Malgorzata Wojtyra and Petra Zrimsek, back to the races after her injury.

The girls will be directed by Walter Zini, who stated: “the Giro Rosa just finished a week ago, the girls didn't have much time to prepare, but their performances were getting better by the end of the race. Now we're getting ready for another important race, with a difficult elevation profile. All the participants are strong athletes, this is a really important race and not only for the German participants. Determination and strength are in our DNA, so obviously we want to do well, but we'll also have to see how the race goes stage by stage.”
