Walter Zini's team, 7th in the UCI world ranking, prepares for an intense, important season.

The recent announcement that BePink ranked 7th in the UCI world ranking gave new motivation and confidence to the team. The team manager, Walter Zini, stated: "It's a great satisfaction to be one of the top ten teams in the UCI ranking, it was definitely one of our main goals. The 7th place allows us to tackle/face the upcoming season with more confidence and calm. Next year we will take part in all the important races. Since our team is just starting out, I'd say it's a great start"

The season is not open yet, but the Italian team is already meeting its goals.

Since yesterday, the Italian champion Noemi Cantele and the young athlete Eleonora Patuzzo are training with the Italian national team: a pre-olympic preparation, in order to be ready for the London Olympics in 2012.

The two athletes will be training in Calpe, a small town in Spain not far from Valencia, until January 29th. Thanks to the warmer temperatures there, the athletes will be able to prepare to be fully competitive from the very beginning of the season.

The other girls of the team are also training intensely in Versilia, Tuscany.

After the first training camp in Cervinia, this is a new occasion to grow and train together.

BePink's first season is about to start: the first race, Het Volk, is scheduled for Saturday, February 25th, in Belgium.

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
